1. Choose a Dental Practice with a Medical-Grade Water System

Most dental equipment requires a direct connection to water supply systems. This equipment should be connected to an uncontaminated water supply during dental procedures. Surprisingly, a number of dentists don't observe proper filtration methods when treating patients and may end up using (unfiltered and untreated tap water). This can put your health, and that of your loved ones at great risk as the equipment is likely to be contaminated with certain water microbes.

Confirming that your dentist has invested in a medical-grade water system ensures that you and your family are protected from nosocomial (hospital-related) infection and outbreaks. The medical system should have a high-quality filtration system that filters and purifies water used in the dentist's office.

A professional practice should be able to explain the measures they've put in place to ensure that they have sufficient clean, highly filtered, and expertly purified water. They

should also inform you about the waterline treatment protocols that they have put in place to avoid the accumulation of bacteria colonies on the interior surfaces of water line tubing.

This microbial accumulation in tubes is known as the biofilm. It is a brown or greenish slimy sludge of bacteria that sticks to moist surfaces such as the internal parts of dental unit waterlines.

Avoid visiting a dentist if they don't have measures in place to ensure an office-wide supply of clean filtered water. You would be exposing your loved ones to grave health risks as the dental equipment may be ridden with waterborne microorganisms.

2. Ensure the Dental Office Has Fully a Functional One-flow Sterilization Process

One-flow sterilization is an essential step to prevent cross-contamination when reprocessing reusable dental instruments that are potentially contaminated with blood, saliva, or other biological fluids. According to the CDC, surgical instruments can be classified as either critical, semi-critical, or non-critical instruments depending on their risks of transmitting diseases. Each of these instruments requires different sterilization measures to kill, deactivate, or eliminate all forms of microbial life.

Proper sterilization ensures that your safety and that of your kids remains a top priority. However, many dentists still sterilize their instruments in an ultrasound machine. The problem with this is that the machine's water, if not properly cleaned after each use, can easily get contaminated, creating a "DNA Soup."

As a result, the liquid content from the injector may flow back, introducing bacteria-ridden blood and saliva drawn from the previous patient into your mouth.

A backflow prevention mechanism ideally allows for only one-way flow or suction, thus preventing bacteria and other infectious agents from flowing from the saliva injector into your mouth. This lessens the risk of patient-to-patient contamination tremendously.

This is a must-have mechanism in any professional dental office that is committed to sound infection control practices. Whether you're looking for a dentist to do minor dental procedures or major ones, you should first ask if they use backflow prevention devices to keep your family safe. Ask to see the inside of the dental suction valve.
